# Pastor Recommended Reading List

## **Updated Spring 2021**

After being requested on a few occasions to create a recommended reading list, I hope this serves those who are interested. Under each major category, I offer suggestions in three tiers—beginner, intermediate, and advanced.

<u>A beginner book</u> is usually under 200 pages, reads easily for those in high school or beyond, and serves as an important introduction to the theme.

<u>An intermediate book</u> is anywhere from 150-350 pages, goes into greater depth than a beginner book, and is usually a more difficult read because of vocabulary, developed reasoning/thoughts, etc.

<u>An advanced book</u> has no maximum page length and is suited for those with a good foundation in basic Christian beliefs, the Bible, and some knowledge of literature, culture, and the arts.
